Help design the Nebraska HOSA state pin! This pin will be used as Nebraska's trading pin at the HOSA International Leadership Conference in June. The rules for entry are listed below.

- 1. Any active, dues paid HOSA chapter may enter the contest.
- The design must relate to Nebraska HOSA (remember to keep it very simple it will be reduced to 3/4" to 1" -- a simple, clear design will transfer best). The use of the current year in the pin design is at your discretion.
- 3. The prototype design must be submitted as a digital version to hosanebraska@gmail.com. All designs must adhere to all copyright and licensing regulations and requirements. Clipart or any other pre-designed graphic will not be accepted.
- 4. A <u>MAXIMUM</u> of 3 colors (in addition to white) may be used.
- 5. Remember the name of our organization is "HOSA Future Health Professionals." By using just "HOSA", the design will be much cleaner and transfer into a pin much better.
- The winning design will be the inspiration for the Nebraska HOSA pin for the year. Nebraska HOSA does have the right to simplify the design.
- 7. The winning designer's chapter will receive acknowledgement at the SLC.
